Applying for a Super Visa?

If you're the parent or grandparent of a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, you may be eligible for the Super Visa program. This visa is valid for up to 10 years and allows you to visit your family in Canada for up to 2 years without renewing your status.

Just remember—you must have valid emergency medical insurance to qualify for the Super Visa. The Canadian government requires a minimum of \$100,000 in coverage for at least one year, so get TuGo Travel Insurance today.
